

## MIFFLIN COUNTY ANNOUNCES POLLING LOCATION CHANGES FOR JUNE 2 PRIMARY ELECTION

**LEWISTOWN** – The Mifflin County Voter Registration & Elections Office has announced that a number of polling precincts have been combined for the upcoming June 2, 2020 Primary Election.

“Act 12 of 2020 granted counties emergency relief to consolidate polling locations for the upcoming 2020 presidential primary election due to COVID-19. This allows counties to operate fewer polling places on Election Day by assigning more than one precinct to a given location. We have taken advantage of this opportunity,” Pamela Powell, director of the Mifflin County Voter Registration and Elections Office, said.

“Many of our poll workers are senior citizens, and we have had some workers indicate that they are not willing to work this election due to the COVID-19 pandemic,” Powell added. “It will be a big help to us to be able to condense the total number of poll locations for this election.”

Powell noted that requests for mail-in ballots for the upcoming election have been pouring in daily, with the latest total count exceeding 2,500.

“In the last Presidential Primary in 2016, we had 10,190 voters cast ballots here in Mifflin County. That was a contested primary on both the Democratic and Republican tickets for president,” Powell revealed.

The Mifflin County voter rates for the Primary Election in the past two years were considerably lower. A total of 5,392 voters turned out in 2018, while 6,203 voters made their way to the polls for last year’s Primary Election.

Voters are invited to complete a mail-in or absentee ballot application online at [Votespa.com](https://votespa.com). You can also print an application from this site, or you can contact the Department of State and request an application by emailing [ra-voterreg@pa.gov](mailto:ra-voterreg@pa.gov) or calling 1-877-VOTESPA.

“Voters can also print these applications under the voter registration department tab on the Mifflin County website,” Powell noted. “You can also get a printed application at the Mifflin County Courthouse. You can also call our office at the Courthouse at 717-248-6571, option 1, and an application will be mailed to you.

A mail-in application is for no excuse absentee voting. An absentee application is only for people who will be absent from the municipality or have a physical disability preventing them from going to the polls.

Powell noted that voters who choose to become a permanent mail-in or absentee will receive a ballot for the primary and the general election, and in the following years they will automatically receive a mail-in or absentee application.

The last day to register to vote in the primary is May 18. The last day to apply for a mail-in or absentee ballot is May 26.
