**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER**

AND NOW, this 16<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2020, in an effort to take precautions to prevent the spread of COVID-19, the Court Orders as follows:

1. Other than employees, no one will be permitted past waiting areas in the Domestic Relations Office.
2. All litigants will be encouraged to use ePASCES online services.
3. Exchange of documents will be conducted via regular mail, e-mail and facsimile whenever possible. If none of these options are feasible, relevant documents may be delivered to the Domestic Relations Office by hand and copied at the office.
4. All support conferences will be held via telephone.
5. For conferences already scheduled, litigants will be contacted and advised of the above procedures.
6. The Director of the Domestic Relations Office has the authority to make exceptions to this Order after consultation with the President Judge.
7. This Order is effective immediately and will remain in effect until further Order of this Court.
