Mifflin County Correctional Facility 2017 Annual PREA Report

Purpose

To publish data and information in accordance with the National PREA Standards

Facts

The Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003 (PREA) was enacted to address the instances of sexual abuse in prison populations. PREA requires all correctional facilities to collect and report detailed information regarding sexual victimization of prisoners.

The Mifflin County Correctional Facility (MCCF) will collect data on all allegations of sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Annually the data is aggregated to complete the U.S. Department of Justice Survey of Sexual Victimization. The data is reviewed and utilized to assess and improve the effectiveness of current policies regarding sexual abuse prevention, detection, and response. This report is the first annual report on sexual abuse and sexual harassment for 2017. This report indicates Mifflin County Correctional Facility's commitment to fully implementing the PREA standards.

Statistics for 2017

December 31, 2017 MCCF had 164 prisoners in confinement. The total of new commitments to MCCF for 2017 was 1,551. The Average Daily Population was 165.

There were a total of (6) PREA complaints. Of the six complaints, two were unsubstantiated staff-on-inmate complaints. One was a complaint of staff-on-inmate sexual harassment activity, which was found to be substantiated, and three were unsubstantiated inmate-on-inmate claims.

Review

The Mifflin County Correctional Facility Administrative Staff shall review all substantiated complaints in 2017.

The following corrective actions have been taken to move toward PREA compliance:

- Fully complied with the 2017 PREA Audit.
- Added new facility wide security camera system.

The Mifflin County Correctional Facility continues to make the availability of victim services through the Abuse Network.

Conclusion

The Mifflin County Correctional Facility has responded to all complaints and continues to make efforts for preventing, detecting, and responding to sexual assault and sexual harassment claims. The goal of Mifflin County Correctional Facility is to continue providing a safer prison for the prisoners and staff by applying the standards for PREA.
