The Board of Mifflin County Commissioners met for a Special Meeting on Tuesday, February 16, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. In attendance were Commissioners Lisa V. Nancollas and Kevin P. Kodish; Chief Clerk Cathy Romig, and Solicitor Stephen Snook. Commissioner Dunkle was absent.

Kiernan Schalk of The Sentinel/County Observer was the only representative present from the news media.

The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Chairman Nancollas.

A. Adoption of 2016 Budget

Motion was made by Commissioner Kodish to adopt the 2016 budget. Commissioner Nancollas stepped from the chair seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

Commissioner Kodish stated that the bottom line of the budget did not change. The total budget is \$25,853,887.00. He stated the Commissioners are refinancing a bond this year and they anticipated conservatively the savings to be \$150,000.00. They are planning to use this saving to purchase a new phone system. There is also an additional \$15,000.00 for the library and the other changes were minor and there were some salary adjustments.
