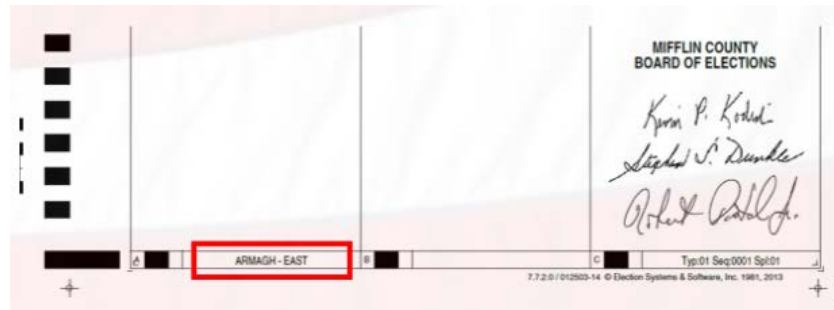


NOVEMBER 6, 2018 GENERAL ELECTION SPECIMEN BALLOTS
